



Handmade Seed Pots

What you will need:

Empty toilet paper rolls or paper towel tubes.

These seed pots are biodegradable!



What to do:

1. Flatten your empty tube along its length, creasing the cardboard at the edges.
2. Open it up, turn it a quarter of a turn, and flatten again. These four creases will turn your tube into a square box.
3. Cut your paper towel tube into three sections. You can also cut your toilet roll a bit shorter if you like.
4. At one end of each section, make four evenly spaced cuts approximately 2cm. These will form the flaps that will close across the bottom of the pot.
5. Fold in each cut flap inwards to close one end of the tube and make as base. It's okay if there is a small gap between the flaps—this will help with drainage.
6. You're done! Fill you pot with propagating mix and get planting.
