



Handmade Seed Pots

What you will need:

Empty toilet paper rolls or paper towel tubes.



What to do:

- 1. Flatten your empty tube along its length, creasing the cardboard at the edges.
- 2. Open it up, turn it a quarter of a turn, and flatten again. These four creases will turn your tube into a square box.
- 3. Cut your paper towel tube into three sections. You can also cut your toilet roll a bit shorter if you like.
- 4. At one end of each section, make four evenly spaced cuts approximately 2cm. These will form the flaps that will close across the bottom of the pot.
- 5. Fold in each cut flap inwards to close one end of the tube and make as base. It's okay if there is a small gap between the flaps—this will help with drainage.
- 6. You're done! Fill you pot with propagating mix and get planting.
