What's involved

A First Nations educator will lead children through a fun, hands-on cultural session. They'll make animal sounds on the didgeridoo and show easy dance moves like kangaroo, emu and lizard that children can dance along with. Children will create artwork using Aboriginal tracks and symbols, then enjoy a Dreamtime story.

Our passionate educators share lots of interesting facts during the session to help little ones understand and appreciate First Nations culture.
