What's involved

Our First Nations educator will lead a fun, hands-on bush tucker adventure where little learners explore the plants, smells and flavours that grow on Country. This session introduces children to our native foods and helps them understand how they are used and cared for.

During the session, children make their own seed bombs in a fun, hands-on activity that lets them help new plants grow at home or in their early learning centre.
