What's involved

Children will head off on an exciting native animal hunt around your ELC, searching high and low for hidden Australian animals - they might spot a cheeky kookaburra or a cute wombat! Once all our animals are safely found, we'll get to know our furry and feathered friends and discover some of the amazing sounds they make. Children can listen carefully, guess which animal is calling, and have a go at making the calls themselves!
