



Little Explorers in Nature

From spotting bird nests in gum trees or noticing native flowers beginning to bloom, there is so much for children to discover in nature! This session is ideal for ELC groups that want to help little learners build confidence outdoors and develop an early awareness of their local environment.

Age level

3+

Number of children per session

Up to 30 children per session.

Location

ELC and/or a nearby park.

Duration

1 hour.

Timing

All year round, but best in Spring when plants are flowering and wildlife is more active.





What's involved

Our educators will take children on a slow-paced, guided walk around your ELC or a nearby park/creek and show children simple ways to notice plants and animals. Children become little detectives in their own environment, noticing flowers, bird and insect activity and other natural features.

This interactive session blends environmental knowledge with real-world observation, encouraging children to slow down and observe their local environment.
