Time to get your hands dirty! This fun session teaches children how to make handmade seed bombs using native plant seeds. This session is great for ELC groups that enjoy hands-on, creative activities and want a fun way to explore nature and learn more about our local wildlife.

Location

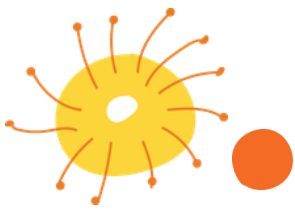

Timing

All year round. Seed bombs best planted in late Winter.



What's involved

Children get to make their very own seed balls using native seeds. Our educator shares fun, simple ideas about how these plants help animals and keep the bush happy and healthy. The session includes all materials and native seeds, as well as planting instructions so that children can plant the seed bombs when they dry (2-3 days after session).
